that the following resolution be adopted:

BE IT RESOLVED THAT there be established a County Policy on Nepotism, in accordance with Section 71.1 of the Code of Iowa, 1975, to read as follows:

It shall hereafter be ^{in violation of Polk County Personnel Regulations} unlawful for any person elected or appointed to any public office or position, under the laws of the state, to appoint as Deputy, Clerk or helper in said office or position to be paid from the public funds, any person related by consanguinity or affinity, within the third degree, to the person elected or appointed.

~~BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT there be established a County Policy where the employment of two or more persons in the same family will not be permitted within the same department...~~

WHEREAS, "family" shall be defined as including an employee's spouse, children, other dependent minors, parents, step-parents, sisters, brothers, sister-in-law and brother-in-law.
